# Recycled Water Policy

- ▶ State Water Resources Control Board adopted Recycled Water Policy – 2009
- ▶ Recycled Water Policy requires Salt/Nutrient Management Plans (SNMPs) completed by May 2014
- ▶ Goal:
  - *Facilitate basin-wide management of salts and nutrients from all sources in a manner that optimizes recycled water use while ensuring protection of groundwater supply and beneficial uses, agricultural beneficial uses, and human health.*
- ▶ Stakeholder driven process

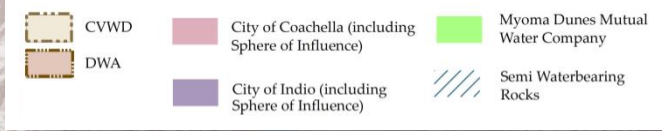
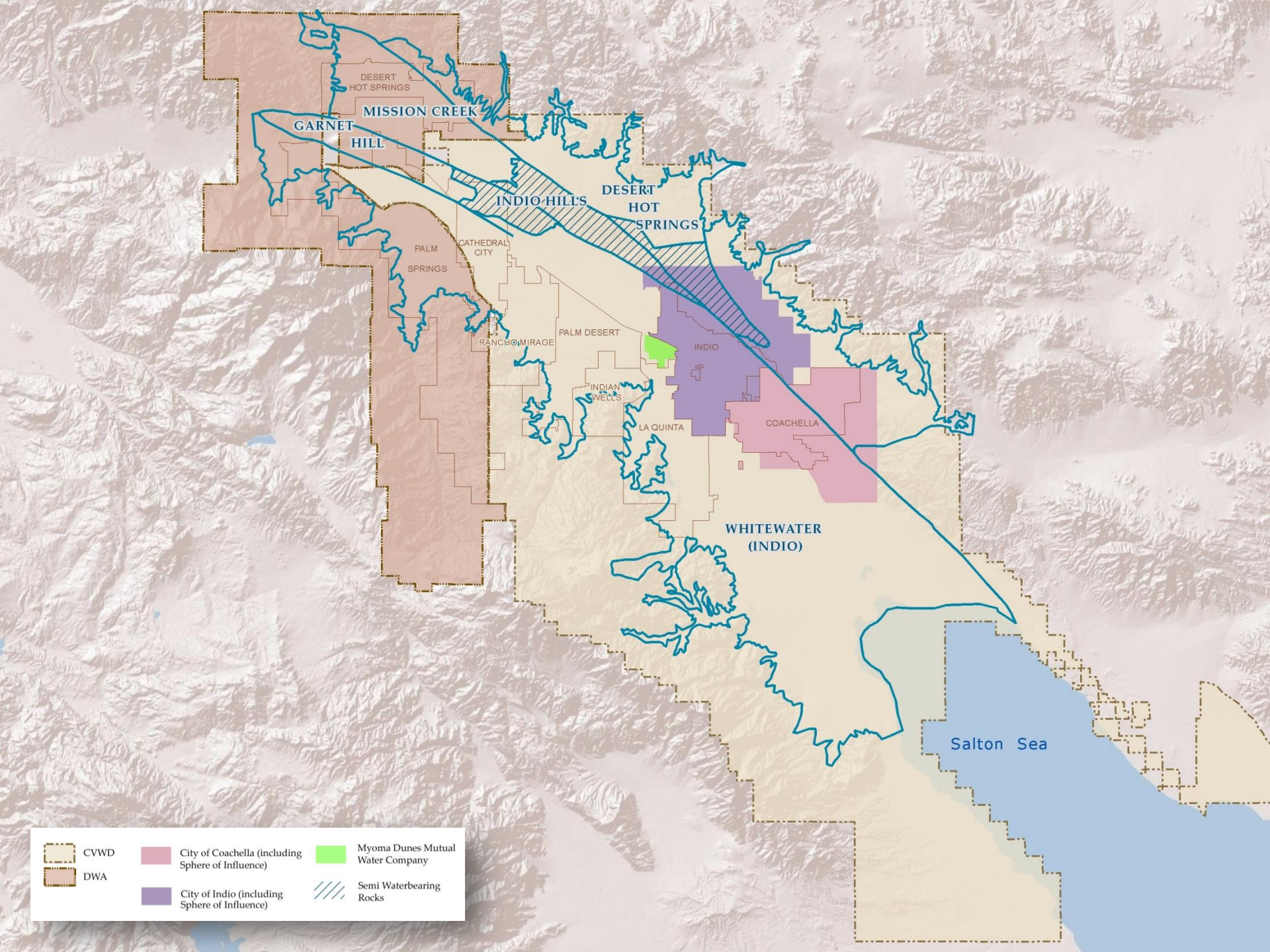
# Coachella Valley SNMP Purpose

- ▶ Identify salt and nutrient loading within the Coachella Valley
  - ▶ Identify and evaluate potential projects and opportunities to improve and protect long-term water quality in the CV groundwater basins
  - ▶ Help to ensure a sustainable water supply
  - ▶ Develop a comprehensive monitoring strategy to protect beneficial uses of CV groundwater supplies

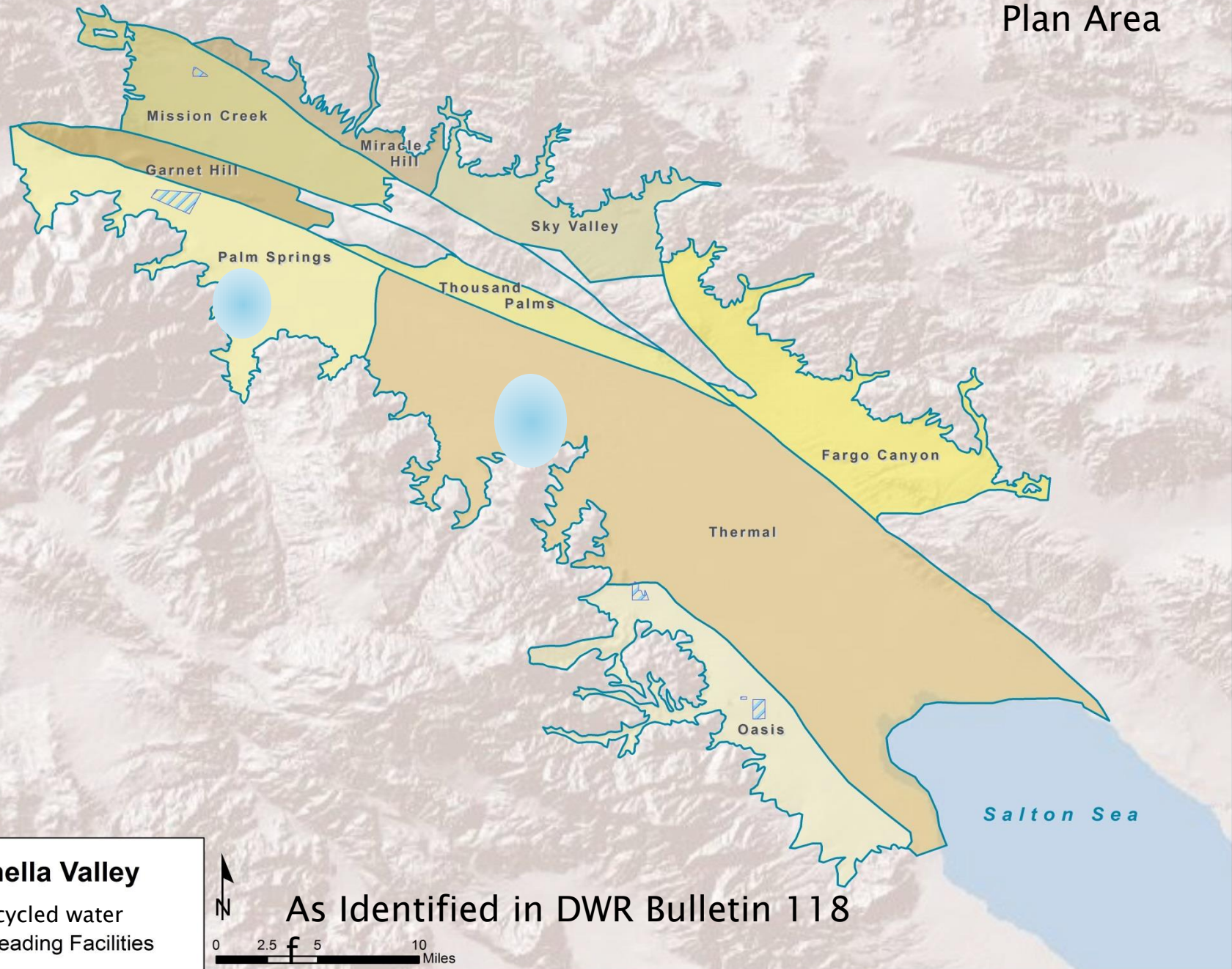

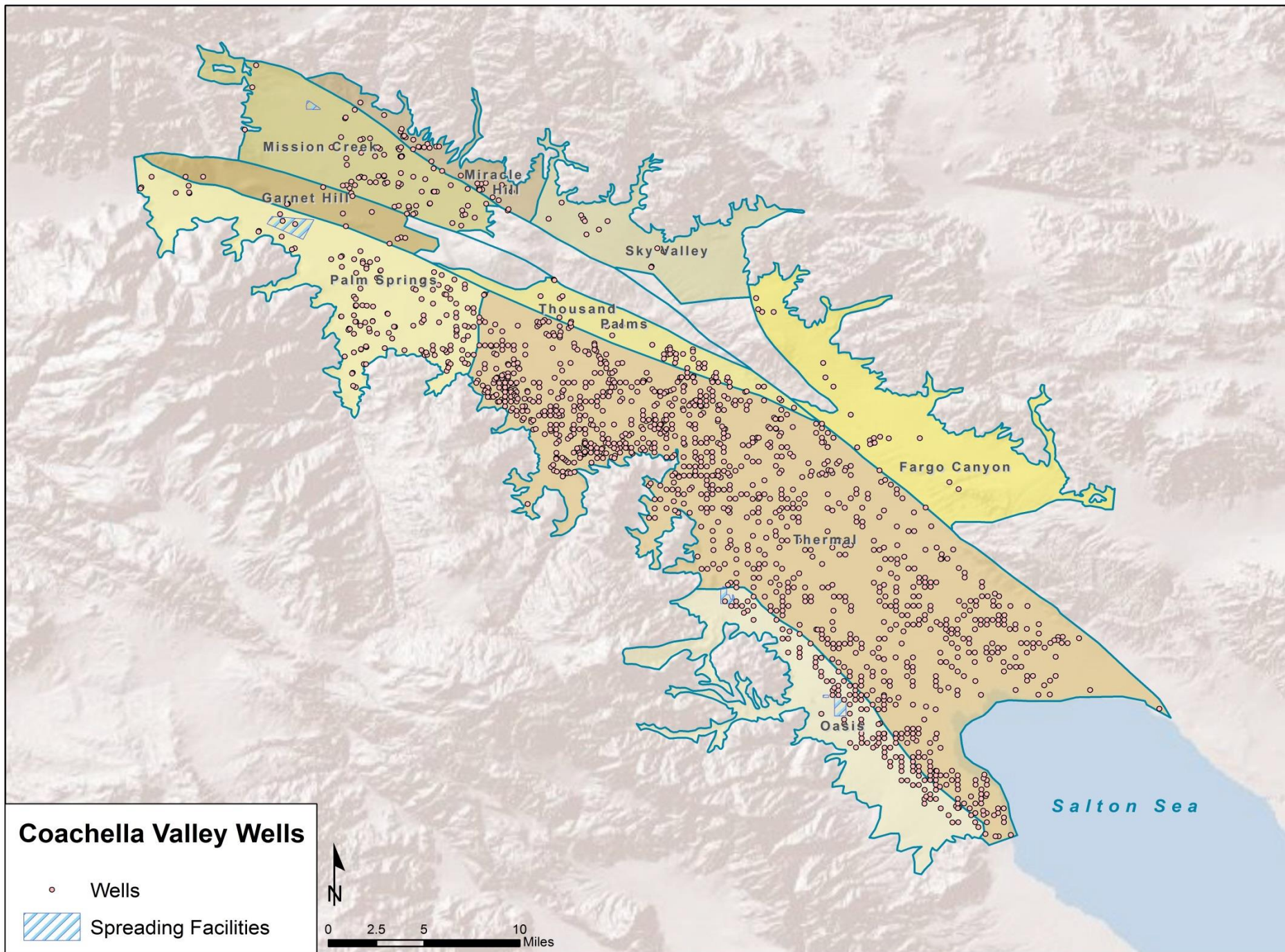
# Plan Area



# Development of the SNMP for the Coachella Valley

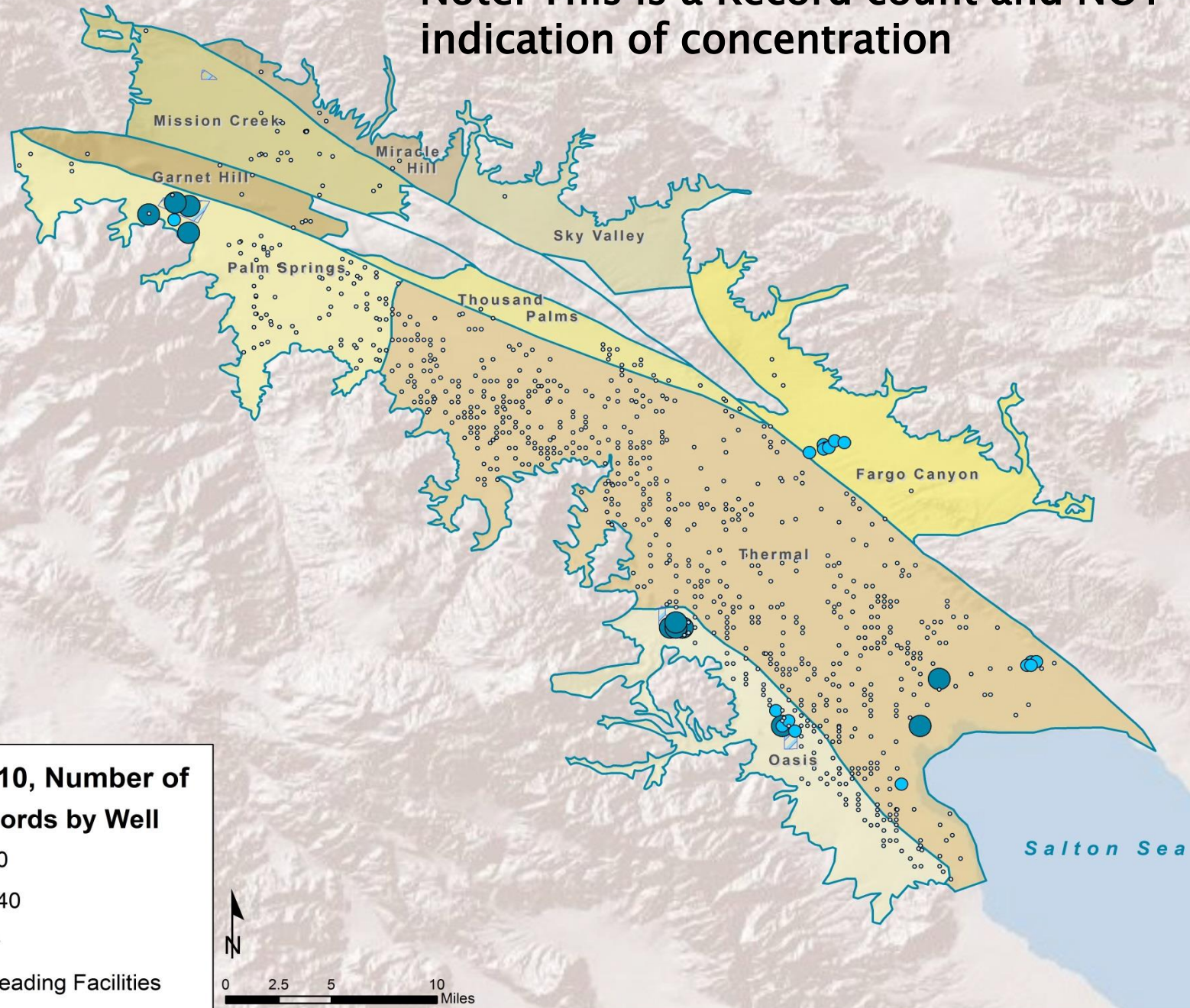
- ▶ Data review and basin characterization
  - ▶ Calculate the exiting water quality for salts and nutrients
  - ▶ Identify Sources and sinks of salts and nutrients
  - ▶ Identify management activities and develop monitoring program to protect water quality

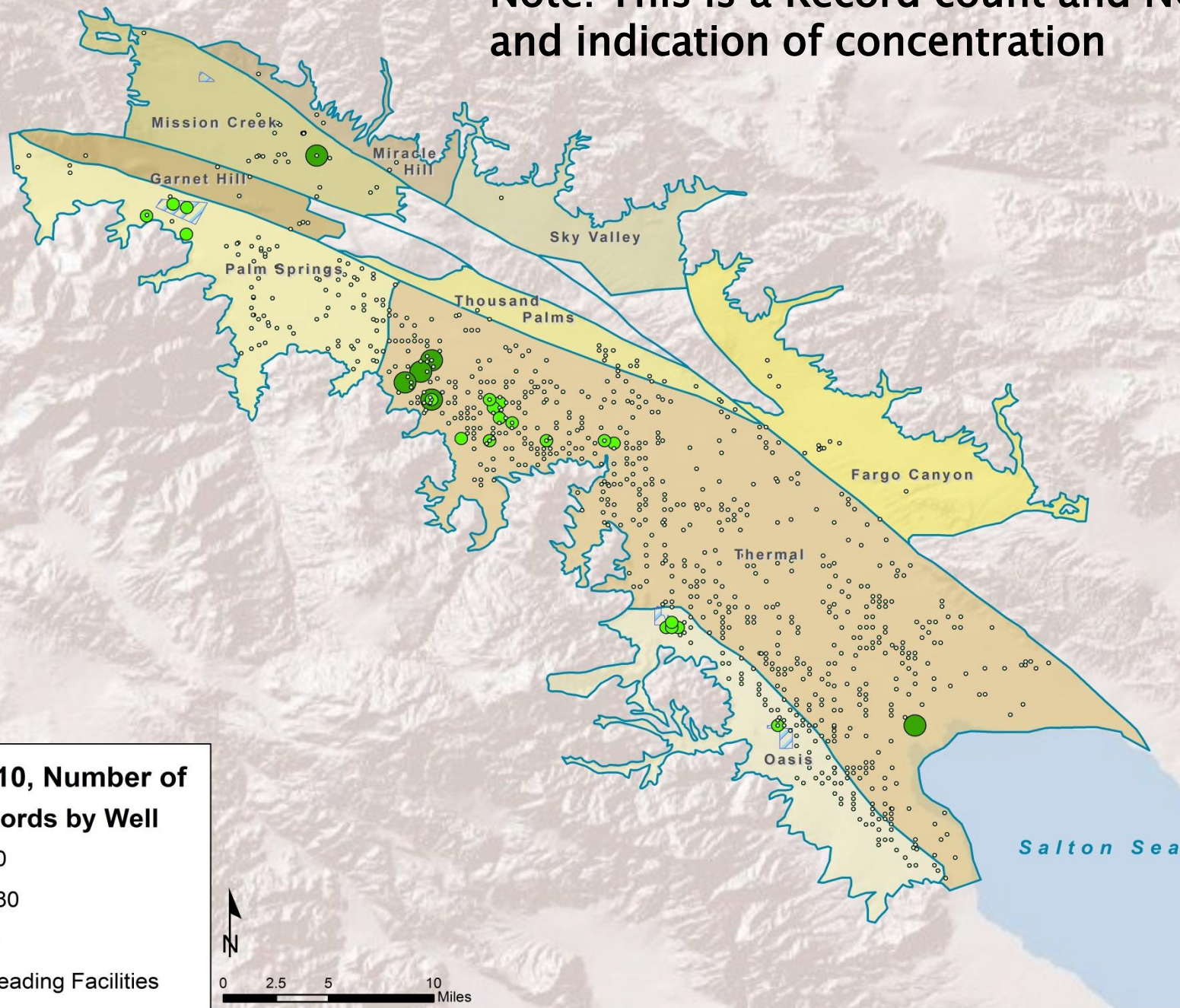
